
Layers of Lace by Hilary Bucci-Pepper of Wightcat Crafts [www.wightcat.com]

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This simple card looks difficult because it has 4 layers. It has been worked on a PCA Fine Diagonal Grid, and finished with a Pergamano Rub On Greeting. The border is effective whether you carry on to make all the layers or just make one single layer.

1 = card base:

The dotted line is the fold line, Cut around the outer perforations, emboss where marked on the pattern and cut a cross in the central 4 needle perforation.

2 =first layer:

Work on a different colour parchment. Cut out all around the outer perforations & glue or sew to the front of card base.

3 = second layer:

Cut out all around outer perforations. Glue or sew to centre of card.

4 = top layer of the card:

The design is outlined with white ink or pencil and embossed. Cut out all around the outer perforations & glue to the 2nd layer.



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
